From One Generation to Another

There's no easy way to express this, but when January 31st rolls around next week it will mark the end of an era: our own Kathy Bryant will retire as she has completed 21 years, and we pray she's able to enjoy a much-deserved rest. It would be hard to express all that Kathy has done for others over the years. She has exemplified a servant's heart for more than two decades. Romans 13 commends us to "give honor to whom honor is due," and we will honor Kathy with a reception here this Saturday from 2:00-4:00.

Change is almost always difficult; we avoid it; we even pretend it isn't coming—but it always is. Across my circle of friends in ministry, I'm hearing of others who are coming to the end of long, distinguished years of service. Time's passing is inevitable, and it is moving each of us through this life and closer to new seasons and closer to Heaven, itself. This is a fact, and it is only morbid to those who have not embraced the Biblical truth that this world is not our ultimate home.

We hear people speak of "the human condition." What is that? It's a way of speaking about the trying situation into which each of us is born. We are each on a journey through this world, and no matter who we are, life's presents plenty of questions and difficulties. This is why when we are blessed with someone who is kind, helpful, and generally makes life easier, we should give thanks for that person. Kathy has certainly been such a person and a blessing.

I sat recently at Zenith Road Baptist Church in Crawford County—(formerly known as Benevolence BC)--the birthplace of Rehoboth Baptist Association. As I looked out at that cemetery, I couldn't help but think of those who have come before us and the tremendous foundation they laid for us to build upon. Then I thought about the legacy each of us is laying and leaving even now. What about those who will come behind *us*? Will they find us to have been faithful?

Psalms 145:4 tells us this: "*One generation shall praise Your works to another, and shall declare Your mighty acts,*" (NKJV). If we think carefully for a moment, there is a two-fold application to this verse: 1.) The first is "Godward"—that is, it speaks of His unwavering Greatness and tremendous Faithfulness; 2.) The second is "usward"—that is we have both the privilege and responsibility to speak of Who God is and what He has done--both to our generation and the one coming behind us. Perhaps we would do well to see ourselves as a link in a chain that stretches from the cross to the coming of Christ.

Even though time brings inevitable changes, the association will go on. For more than 185 years, we have partnered and planned, prayed and prospered, served and sacrificed, witnessed and worked. The true strength for this work comes from a knowledge that the work isn't ours, but The LORD'S. Like those buried at Zenith Rd. and all across the cemeteries of our churches, like Kathy now, and my predecessors, Boe Stanley and Clarence Cox in the past, my day of bowing out will come, too. I am keenly aware of its approach. Like Kathy, I hope I'm still effective and useful until my last day. I also pray to be able to recognize when it's time for me to go.

Abraham's day gave way to that of Isaac and Isaac's to that of Jacob. The sun one day set on Jacob and his life unfolded into that of Joseph and his brothers. Moses' leadership came to an end and gave way to that of Joshua; Joshua to the Judges and the Judges to the Kings. The era of the Old Testament gave way to the New Testament as foretold by Jeremiah. John the Baptist joyfully bowed to the ministry of Jesus and even the ministry and days of our Lord on earth unfolded into the ministry of the Spirit through the apostles. God is the great Rock that does not move—we are transient and passing through: "*LORD make to know my end, and what is the extent of my days; let me know how transient I am,*" (Ps. 39:4).

The great reformer, Martin Luther said he only kept two dates on his calendar: "*This day and THAT DAY.*" He meant he was aware yesterday is gone; tomorrow is something we are not promised; all we have is TODAY—and we must live it in light of THAT DAY—The Day we stand before God. It is a privilege to be a part of something so wonderful and so much bigger than ourselves: The Kingdom of our GOD. What a privilege it is to serve Him for a time and to know and worship HIM for all eternity!

Praise God for a very successful 2022! Praise God for all of the volunteers who helped us in 2022, Praise God for all of the contributions by the churches, companies, and individuals who contributed the required funds to successfully send 1,758 back packs to the mountain children. Praise God for all of the people who helped pack all of the items into back packs. It was the most successful year that we have had. Thanks to everyone! We had many women's groups who helped with making stocking caps, scarfs, and gloves, Additionally, we had women's groups who packed all of the modules we placed into the back packs.

We helped flood victims in Buckhorn Kentucky. and later to the school in Hazard, Kentucky. with furniture, clothes, toys, linen and miscellaneous household items. Early in 2022 we sent credit cards to the Muhlenberg County Baptist Association in Central City Kentucky. to help people who were devastated by the huge tornado that went through their total area.

Through these disasters we have picked up two new partners that we will likely support in the future as they settled. We helped the Spanish Mission (Mar de Galilea) that meets in the Harmony Community Church helping them get started with various required items. We have helped veterans with furniture to get them in a new living environment.

How can **YOU** Help Us?


We desperately need **men** to help us pick up furniture one day a week. This effort is usually accomplished in 4 hours. We need **men** to help load the truck when we are taking furniture to the mountains. The pick up crew takes 4-5 men each week. The loading of the truck takes about 6 men and usually takes 2-3 hours. Our goal is to establish a list of about 48 men or more this would lessen the days that a team would have to work. My bet is that if you came for two weeks you would want to come more often because the volunteers are so great to be around it is like a well-oiled machine working to get the job done for the Lord.



Facts and Trends

- 90% of all Georgia Baptist churches have a Sunday School ministry.
- The 150 fastest-growing Sunday schools in Georgia accounted for 75% of all the baptisms reported. Still, these churches (of all sizes and locations) are only 4% of all the Georgia Baptist churches.
- 100% of the fastest-growing Sunday schools in Georgia provide training for their leaders and start new groups. This separated them from plateaued/declining churches.
- 83% of new Christians that were active in Sunday school remained engaged with their church five years after their profession of faith. Compared to only 16% of those attending worship only.

Ministry Impact

- Sunday school is the church doing the work of the church and brings a clear and intentional strategy of evangelism.
- Sunday school's purpose is centered on the study of the Bible with reaching people with the gospel as believers.
- Sunday school addresses the "how-to" of accomplishing the Great Commission.

Next Steps

- Take an honest look at your Sunday School ministry. Where is it strong, and where does it need improvement?
- Contact the GBMB Discipleship team to assist you in your evaluation and/or contact them to provide custom resources and recommendations to address areas that need improvement.

Watershed Discipleship

- REACH – Christians need to gather together for Bible study, fellowship, and also be sent out to tell the world about Jesus.
- TEACH – The Bible must be at the center of all teaching, and the goal is changed lives.
- MULTIPLY – Sunday school classes need to be starting new classes and sending out people to serve in other age groups.





