How the Mighty Have Fallen . . .and Been Raised Up!

Please don't think I'm a follower of old wives tales, but my mother used to say, "Death often comes in threes." That, strangely has occurred time and again in my circle of friends and family. This very week, we've had three tremendous men of God called home from our midst. I have been privileged to know each of these men on a personal as well as an associational level, and I'm eternally grateful for that privilege afforded me by our LORD. Some of you will recognize the words above in the title as those of David when he learned of Saul and Jonathan's death in battle.

Rev. David Fisher, long-term pastor of FBC Haynesville fell sick just before Christmas. He took a fall as a result of his illness and was hospitalized. I saw him the Saturday before Christmas and became aware of how sick he actually was. Many prayers were offered up for him—his church people meeting regularly in called prayer for their beloved pastor. He showed improvement and was moved out of ICU, but soon had to return there. While he was on the regular floor, I got to sit and talk to him for almost an hour one afternoon. He told me something that meant so much: "I have been a pastor for almost 60 years, and have never really had a pastor, but you have been my pastor, Tim!" What a privilege! I saw him the Saturday before God called him home on Monday, and he was weak, but sweetly at peace. David would've celebrated 30 years as Pastor of FBCH on February 4th. That is a remarkable achievement.

Rev. Bob Gray and his wife Doris have served churches in middle Georgia for decades. Brother Bob served Henderson for several years and his last assignment was as an Associate and staff member at FBC Centerville. Additionally, Bob has served churches in several states. Ms. Doris has served countless hours as our beloved counselor at the dental clinic. Recently, Bro. Bob was diagnosed with advanced cancer. His family cared for him at home until he needed to be moved to Hospice care for his comfort. Last Monday, I stopped by and he was remarkably lucid and not in pain. We got to talk, reminisce, and pray. In his words, "I'm ready for Him to take me home." What a joy to see the saint of God at peace! Bro. Bob didn't have to wait long—less than 72 hours from our visit he was IN HIS PRESENCE.

This one is harder to write: Mr. Emory Wilson, formerly of FBC Ft. Valley, and for many years now of FBC Perry was called home the same day as Bob Gray. I sincerely wanted to go see Emory, but time and being among so many people and exposed to things had kept me from visiting. Emory served for decades here on our local Missions Committee/team. He was a vital part of Bill Glass Prison Ministries and had done hundreds of weekends in prison ministry. His last months were spent at Summerhill and he had shown improvement, but his earthly body of 95 years had simply begun to wear out. I had lunch with him months ago and it was a delight to hear of his basketball coaching, business career, and experiences. Bill Glass Ministries' weekends are often called "Weekend of Champions"—well, Mr. Emory was truly a champion: champion soul-winner, champion fundraiser, and organizer. Every weekend we've ever done in middle Georgia in my 32 years here was due in great part to the efforts and passion of Emory Wilson.

King David in his heartfelt compassion and God-given eloquence spoke the words above when word reached him of his best friend's death, along with David's persecutor and predecessor, Saul. David, ever one who showed respect—even for enemies, rendered a beautiful lament: "The beauty of Israel is slain on your high places! How the mighty have fallen. . . Saul and Jonathan were beloved, and pleasant in their lives. . . swifter than eagles. . . stronger than lions. . . how the mighty have fallen, and the weapons of war perished!" (1 Sam. 1: 17-27).

This week indeed, the mighty among us have fallen, but praise God that is not the end of the story. Each of these men has now passed beyond what each of us dreads and with which we must one day contend: the passing from earthly life to Heavenly life. I am supremely confident if we could speak with them, they'd say the journey is not as bad as our fears have made it. In fact, I believe they'd say it is comforting because of the Holy One Who has gone before us paving the way in His precious blood. They have been raised to a higher, far nobler form of life. We pray for their families and churches, but we rejoice in their peace and reward!

Last year proved to be a very busy year, but 2024 has begun on a slower pace due to the inclement weather in Appalachia. However, as soon as the roads are passable, we will again be providing much needed items to the people of Appalachia.

Praises and Opportunities:

Praises:

Bro. Jim Dutcher, who leads the Second Baptist Church's Men's Ministry, has been a great help to us. First, he committed men from his group to help load furniture the second Saturday of each month. Additionally, he contacted the Men's Ministry leadership at Central Baptist and they have committed to help load the truck on the fourth Saturday of each month. This is a tremendous blessing to the ministry and the comradery that is achieved by the groups working together has been tremendous. **There are still two Saturdays in the month when we need help.** If your men's group would like to give a couple of hours on either the first or third Saturday, please contact me, Pete Soots at (478) 396-9316.

Last year nine people went to Whitley County Kentucky where we handed out backpacks at two different schools. Those who went were totally amazed at what they saw. Children were so excited to receive their backpack and the items in it. Not only did the children receive a backpack, but they were also given a stuffed animal and an additional toy. For many of the children there, this was the only Christmas gift they received. This was only possible because of your generosity.

Opportunities:

DRIVERS: We anticipate this year will be even busier than 2023 as we have made connections with several new ministry partners. This means we can help more people, but it also means we will have to take more loads to our ministry partners and will need more drivers to accomplish that.
