20 Years in Moldova—Where do we go from here?

In 2003, my esteemed predecessor, Bro. Boe Stanley traveled to Moldova to represent the then Georgia Baptist Convention and in doing so, made friendships that continue to this day. His heart was moved by what he saw there and by the commitment of our Baptist brothers and sisters. He made commitments in conjunction with RBA leadership for us to work in Moldova.

I've spent the last 19 years striving to honor those commitments. It has been a joy. We've helped to plant churches; helped the "mother" church (Filadelfia) get a building that has grown and been renovated time and again. We've done evangelistic events such as preaching and Bible School; trained pastors and hosted retreats for those pastors and their wives. We've conducted medical clinics in villages multiple times and provided medicines to those who didn't have any.

Last year, as conflict brought refugees from Ukraine, we aided our pastors and churches in caring for those displaced by the ravages of war. I am grateful for all that has been accomplished. I take no credit for any of it—but give praise to God and give thanks to you—our churches and supporters for opening your hearts and pocketbooks to the needs you saw. I can say with integrity, we have tried to be good stewards of the things with which you entrusted us.

Recent news has brought concerns for our beloved Moldova. The newly-elected Prime Minister resigned under pressure and a new government must be formed. This was reported by the media as a "collapse." Contact with our pastors there show us they are concerned but not alarmed. They express again what they have always expressed: they are in the Hand of God. Still, please pray for them as a significant government change could affect them tremendously and affect our ability to travel there and work. It is in God's Hand.

A recent email from one of our own, Ross Lewis, who grew up at Shirley Hills, was intriguing. You might recall IMB pulled the Lewis' from Ukraine as the war started and they, like all others trying to travel West were in long lines and great adversity. The LORD settled them in Romania, and they are fostering the work there. Ross is interested in partnering with churches here to reach Romania with the Gospel. He will contact us further about opportunities.

April will prayerfully bring an opportunity for me to go to Nicaragua. We have been asked to consider a partnership with pastors and churches in this Central-American country. Pastors there stand in tremendous need of training in sound doctrine and there are many needs I am told. Hopefully a late-April vision trip will identify some of those, and also initiate a relationship with believers there. Having a partnership with Nicaragua would do several things: it would be a new place to minister for those who want to do missions; it would be a shorter trip with less costs than Eastern Europe; and it would prayerfully involve persons across the association who have never done missions.

What am I expressing in mentioning Romania and Nicaragua? I am NOT expressing we are through with Moldova. There is much to be done in Moldova, and our brothers there long for us to come and work with them and to encourage them. God somehow knitted our hearts together with the Baptists of Moldova twenty years ago, and we are not abandoning this partnership. We are simply offering more opportunities and possible alternatives for our church members to be involved in the Great Commission.

Please pray for our brothers in these countries. Pray for lost souls, and those hopeless without Christ. Pray for me and our leaders that we will clearly discern God's will and respond in obedience. Pray regarding what the Holy Spirit would have YOU do about Missions.

I love how our LORD has blessed our partnership in the Gospel; I'm thankful for Southern Baptists and CP, Lottie Moon, Annie Armstrong, etc., but I accepted this position because I believe the God who calls us to give also has called us to GO. The same LORD who told us to pray for workers has also commanded us to point others to Him through service and witnessing. Where do we go from here? I don't know—but HE does—and our task is to discern His Will and do it wherever He leads.

We are praying that each of the churches are praying as what God would have them give for this vital ministry to provide the unfortunate children in the Appalachian Mountains with a back pack this year. We have been busy this month with two loads going to the flooded area up in Buckhorn Ky. We also sent one to Jellico, Tn. There is a large possibility for another to go to Buckhorn yet this month. They are in such need of furniture. The last two loads lasted approximately 2 hours after being offloaded. They are very thankful people and so appreciative.

THAT BRINGS ARE REAL NEED! WE NEED MEN TO VOLUNTEER TO HELP LOAD THE TRUCK WITH FURNITURE. IT ONLY TAKES ABOUT 2 HOURS TO LOAD THE TRUCK. WE NEED SIX MEN TO DO IT WITHOUT PLACING A BURDEN ON ANYONE. WOULD YOU PRAY AND ASK GOD IF HE WOULD HAVE YOU HELP WITH THIS HUGE NEED. WE NEVER LOAD MORE THAN ONE A WEEK WITH FURNITURE. PLEASE HELP!!

We had a very successful coat drive for the folks up in the mountains. We took 15 boxes of coats up to the different areas in the mountains and I know they appreciated them.
